WELCOME TO THE 33RD ANNUAL NORFOLK HARBORFEST® 2009

THE HISTORY OF NORFOLK HARBORFEST®

It began more than a quarter century ago when the Norwegian Tall Ship Christian Radich came to call on Norfolk, a waterfront community that had no city-owned property on which to dock a ship. The ship was docked three blocks from Town Point at the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, and 13,000 people crossed her gangway in just one and a half days. Over the next two years, City planners and leaders created berthing to accommodate more ships, and a waterfront public park was planned. Norfolk Harborfest® was born.

Today, tall ships from all over the world frequently call on the City of Norfolk and nearly half a million visitors gather on the downtown waterfront each year for this annual celebration of our region's rich nautical heritage.

The traditions of the East Coast's Premier Waterfront Festival are celebrated with nautical history, maritime events, visiting vessels, children's activities, local, regional and national entertainment. Festivities stretch from The Waterside Festival Marketplace to the Historic Freemason Harbor.

GENERAL INFORMATION

GUEST RELATIONS, SERVICES, INFORMATION AND SECURITY OFFICE

The Norfolk Harborfest® Guest Relations locations are all-inclusive guest services stations located adjacent to Nauticus and next to the Waterside Festival Marketplace. Guest services include ATM, Lost and Found, directions, information, program schedules and security questions.

LOST AND FOUND

Lost and found items can be reported at the Guest Relations Center adjacent to Nauticus and next to the Waterside Festival Marketplace. Parents with lost children are also asked to check in with Guest Relations or the nearest uniformed police officer. No public address announcements regarding lost persons or items will be made during the event.



FIRST AID

First aid stations are located at both the North Gate and South Gate entrances to Town Point Park.

COMFORT STATION

A private comfort station for infant feeding and diaper changing is located at South Gate entrance to Town Point Park.

SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS

For your safety, bikes, skateboards, roller skates, scooters, motorized vehicles of all types, glass bottles and pets (except designated for disability assistance) are not permitted within the festival boundaries. Bicycle racks are available for those wishing to cycle to Harborfest®, located at the North Gate and South Gate entrances to Town Point Park.

GUESTS WITH DISABILITIES

Norfolk Harborfest® is accessible to persons with disabilities, with parking available at all City parking garages. Wheelchair accessible port-o-lets are located on-site (see map for locations). Special seating accommodations at all stages can be requested from event security or any uniformed staff member. *Town Point Park is in compliance with The American Disabilities Act.*

REST AREAS

Picnic tables are located at the Bluegrass & BBQ Stage. Additional seating is available in the The BOB FM Hard Rockfish Café. Shaded areas are located throughout the park and along Waterside Drive.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEOTAPING

Festivals and Events are photographed and videotaped for future promotional use by professionals employed by Norfolk Festevents who are easily identified by staff credentials. Festivals and events are also photographed and taped by the news media for television and newspaper coverage and are identified by their press credentials.

DIRECTIONS

By Car

Town Point Park, Norfolk's largest waterfront park, is located on Waterside Drive along the banks of the historic Elizabeth River, and situated between the Waterside Festival Marketplace and Nauticus, the National Maritime Center.

From I-64, take I-264 West toward Downtown Norfolk and exit left onto Waterside Drive. The park is located approximately 1/2 mile ahead on the left. Over 19,600 metered and garage parking spaces are conveniently located within walking distance of the park or on the NET bus route.

By Boat

Town Point Park is located at Mile Marker Zero on the Intracoastal Waterway on the Elizabeth River and is easily accessible by boat. Please visit festevents.org or call 757.441.2345 for more information.

PARKING

There are over 19,600 parking spaces in Downtown Norfolk within an easy walk to Norfolk Harborfest® or on the free NET Bus route. Flat pre-pay rates will be in effect at designated city-owned garages and lots beginning at 4 pm on Friday and continuing until 8 pm on Sunday. The NET Bus is a free bus service that will run Friday until 11 pm, Saturday until midnight and Sunday until 8:00 pm. Docking along the Downtown Norfolk Waterfront is prohibited. Docking is by advance reservation only- **unauthorized boats will be towed at owner's expense.**

DINGHY DOCKING

Short term, transient dinghy docking is available on first come first serve basis at the Dinghy Dock located by the USS Wisconsin; docking at boater's own risk. Docking limited to dinghy boats, 12' or less only- all others towed at owner's expense.

WVEC-TV PARADE OF SAIL:

FRIDAY 12:00 NOON ON THE ELIZABETH RIVER
At "high noon" on Friday, July 3, Norfolk will welcome the Parade of Sail as it enters the Downtown Norfolk Harbor. Following tradition, an expansive fleet of tall ships, character vessels, sleek power cruisers, sailing craft, antique and classic wooden boats, military vessels, tugs and more, will salute thousands of onlookers stationed at vantage points along the Elizabeth River – the larger portion of the crowd expected to be viewing from Town Point Park officially reopens July 4th weekend after closing in October 2008 for a complete makeover. The tall ships taking part in the parade of sail will leave Waterside Marina at **7:30 am, Friday, July 3** and rally with the rest of the participating vessels at Sewells Point at 9 am. The Parade will depart Sewells Point at 10 a.m. and enter the Downtown Norfolk Harbor (passing Nauticus Pier) at 12 Noon.

SHIP TOURS

Ships will be open for public tours on Saturday, July 4 (some ships may be open for limited hours on Friday following the Parade of Sail). Public tours begin at 12 noon Saturday and conclude at sunset, unless otherwise posted at the ship. Visitors are requested to wear flat shoes and be able to manage walking up and down access ramps and ladders. Strollers must be left on the dock.
